



2011 - 2012 Scholarship Application

The Award

The New Jersey Credit Union League's Youth Involvement Board (YIB) scholarship is an award of up to \$1,000 to be paid jointly to the winning student and the student's chosen accredited educational institution.

Eligibility

The applicant must be a member in good standing of a participating credit union and must be enrolled as a high school senior at the time of the application.

Scholarship funds must be used: 1. for tuition or textbooks; 2. only at an accredited educational institution (2- or 4-year college, university, or technical/vocational school).

Application Process

Eligible members must complete this scholarship application in its entirety. A student may submit only one application through one credit union. In the event a student submits more than one application, only one will be considered.

1. The application must be completed and signed by a management-level official of the student's participating credit union.
2. The signed application must be submitted with the following:
 - An official high school transcript. Transcript must be NON-WEIGHTED on a 4.0 scale.
 - An SAT/ACT transcript provided through the student's school guidance office. Students who are not required to take either the SAT or ACT do not need to provide any test paperwork and the absence of their scores will not count against them in the scholarship consideration process.
 - The completed Teacher Reference portion of the application. It must be completed by one of the applicant's teachers and returned in a sealed, signed envelope.
3. The application, transcript(s), and Teacher Reference must be returned to the participating credit union by the application deadline. If any portion of the application is incomplete or not included (excluding the SAT/ACT transcript for those for whom it is not required), the applicant will be disqualified.

Selection Process

Judging will be based on academic performance, extracurricular activities, community service/involvement, references, and personal goals. Credit unions will be notified of the scholarship winner by May 25, 2012.

Application Deadline

Student must return applications to their credit unions on or before April 2, 2012.
